GENERAL REGULATIONS

a) Entries must be received on the Society's form by the closing date and accompanied by the proper fees as specified within the schedule. Nominations not accepted.

b) A member of the Society is entitled to make entries at a reduced fee provided the membership subscription has been paid by the closing date of entry and a direct debit form is completed and returned with entry form.

All entries must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor for at least 3 calendar months prior to the Show. Imported animals will be referred to DEFRA / Welsh Government for verification status.

Entries in the hands of the Secretary are not transferrable nor can they be after the closing date.

e) The Committee reserve the right to reject any entry without stating the reason for doing so.

f) The age(in years and months) or height of animals exhibited for premiums must be fairly stated in certificates. In case of dispute, assessment by the Show's Veterinary Surgeons is final.

g) Exhibitors must have MV forms available for checking as they enter stock lines.

h) All bull exhibitors must provide two handlers to be present at all times when the bull is on the showground.

i) No goat entries will be accepted unless the registration number is quoted on the entry form (see separate entry form for goat entries).

j) An AHS Registration photocopy must be enclosed with this form where appropriate.

k) All exhibitors should have a policy of public liability insurance. The Society will accept no liability for any resultant losses or claims.

l) All Horse exhibitors must carry passports.

PASSES WILL BE SENT TO EXHIBITORS ON PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES. IF YOU REQUIRE ADDITIONAL PASSES FOR EXTRA ATTENDEES, THESE MAY BE PURCHASED AT THE CURRENT RATE OF £9.00 EACH VIA THE WEBSITE OR AT THE GATE. ANYONE WITHOUT A VALID PASS WILL BE OBLIGED TO PAY AT THE GATE.
