The Brecknockshire Agricultural Society Safety Policy Statement

The Brecknockshire Agricultural Society (BAS) recognises that under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, it has a legal duty to ensure, so far as it is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare of all people (staff and visitors) attending the County Show on the first Saturday in August.

The BAS will ensure that all tasks and responsibilities are carried out in such a way as to comply with the requirements of the Committee in planning the Brecon County Show as effectively as possible whilst protecting the safety and wellbeing of all parties attending.

The report identifies how the event will comply with current health and safety legislation.

The committee of the Society has three main aims:

Ground / Site

To maintain the ground in a good condition and to improve the site wherever possible.

Management / Staffing

To ensure that all parties concerned in the planning and discharging of their responsibilities to the Society are enabled to do so as effectively as possible and are recognised to be competent in their areas of responsibility.

Overview of Show Day

To analyse the planning, practices and procedures of previous years' shows to ensure as far as possible that any problems or deficiencies which may have been experienced are not repeated and that year-on-year improvement is achieved.

The BAS will take such steps as is reasonably practicable:


1. To maintain safe and healthy working practices, systems and methods of work to protect all employees, visitors and others in so far as they come into contact with foreseeable hazards.

2. To develop safety awareness and create a climate for individual responsibility for health and safety at all levels.

3. To provide a safe environment for all visitors to the showground bearing in mind that visitors may not necessarily be attuned to certain aspects of the environment.

4. To control effectively the activity of all outside contractors when on the showground.

5. To ensure that this Policy is used as a practical working document, the Committee have appointed a Health and Safety Officer who is considered "a competent person" in the discharge of his duties.

Recipe(Class4)

BANANA AND LIME LOAF

Ingredients:

225g / 8oz Self Raising Flour 115g/ 4oz margarine 175g/6oz caster sugar 2 ripe bananas 115g/4oz sultanas 1 egg Juice and rind of 2 limes 5 fl.oz natural yogurt

<u>Topping</u>

115g/4oz icing sugar Lime juice Lime rind

METHOD

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C/160°C Fan/Gas Mark 4. Grease and line 2lb loaf tin
- 2. Rub fat into flour. Add sugar, bananas mashed with juice of 1 lime, rind of 1 lime, yogurt and beaten egg.
- 3. Add sultanas and mix well until thoroughly incorporated.
- **4.** Spoon mixture into loaf tin and bake for 40 50 minutes or until firm to the touch.
- 5. Cool in the tin for 10 minutes then turn onto a wire rack.
- 6. To make the topping, sift the icing sugar into a small bowl and mix with the lime juice to form a soft but not too runny icing. (You might not need all the remaining lime juice)
- 7. Smooth icing over the top of the cake and sprinkle with remaining lime rind.
